Catching up with Sea Life at Fitzgerald Marine Reserve in Moss Beach

Spending some time at this tidepool treasure south of San Francisco might be what enjoying an afternoon on the moon is like. The countless dark rocks and crater-like seascape at low tide give the Fitzgerald Marine Reserve an almost unearthly quality that magnifies its beauty. Take the walking trail that loops through grassy fields and meanders along a bluff rising above lush tidepools unequalled on the Pacific coast. Plan to be there at low tide, when a breathtaking array of sea life emerges: sea stars, anemones, sponges, mollusks, fish and crab appear in abundance as you have never seen them before. Low tide schedules are posted, or call ahead to take advantage of walking among the ragged sea floor pools and behold the sights and smells unique to this oceanic phenomenon.
